Pav 62.26/27 APOLOGIES – None received

Pav 63.26/27 FOPL

- a. DF signed FOPL agreement on 22nd June.
- b. Replacement Reader – thoughts were shared regarding a replacement for the reader sculpture:
 - i. a possible metal sculpture to inc reading
 - ii. recycling theme
 - iii. exhibition space,
 - iv. possible - business sponsorship
 - v. write an article for the newsletter to ask public for suggestions for new sculpture

Pav 64.26/27 PAVILION ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

- a. Pavilion Income and Expenditure. After a proposal from Cllr Trow, seconded by Cllr Hignett, it was **RESOLVED** that the Income & Expenditure for the Pavilion was approved and signed accordingly.
- b. British Gas - the new SEG tariff was noted.
- c. Pavilion Reserves – it was confirmed that the Pavilion Reserves are held in a CCLA account and receive interest. Committee members would like to know what the % interest on Pavilion reserves is?

Pav 65.26/27 PAVILION OPERATIONAL MATTERS

- a. PSG Works Schedule – it was noted that confirmation of the FRA work had been completed
- b. After a proposal by Cllr Hignett, seconded by Cllr Trow it was **RESOLVED** that retrospective agreement be given to replace the toilet fan.
- c. It was reported that one square planter had been removed due to rotten wood and will not be replaced. Committee members would like to review how things are progressing next year.
- d. Air Conditioning. A request for air conditioning units had been made due to the intensely hot weather. Committee members suggested the following:
 - i. To put reflective film on windows
 - ii. Can the Pavilion hire air conditioning units?
 - iii. Do nothing in 2026

- iv. How much revenue we have lost due to heat?
- vi. Look at portable units – need to review.
- vii. Cost effective – how much would it be on the electric.
